

LORDS OF THE SKY by DAN HAMPTON


Book Review by Lynn Petty

In the January Issue I gave a book review of Tanker Pilot which is a really good book that gives you pause on the importance of refueling a/c. I swapped books with a friend of mine and just completed reading Lord of the Sky which I found equally as good! Witten as the cover says by the author of *Viper Pilot*, Dan Hampton knows his subject as he is a F16 master. Like the cover says the time period covered is WW1 Thru the second Gulf War. Rather than just wrote about things from the fighter pilot view Mr. Hampton has done a masterful job of weaving together a chronological view that ties in the technological developments that go with fighter aircraft, the concurrent status of the ground battle, and the training methods and their impact on the quality of pilots at the front. This is second book in recent times for me that I found hard to put down. You ca get the paperback for around \$10 with the hardcover not much more. Recommended!










From David Beckman
