50 Years Ago by Rob Schorry.

The crew of Apollo 8 - Frank Borman, Jim Lovell, and Bill Anders - orbited the Moon, the first humans to do so (as well as the first to ride a Saturn V).

They circled the Moon ten times in twenty hours and then returned home, paving the way for the first lunar landing less than seven months later. While 'out there' they photographed the lunar surface, tested their spacecraft, and made a memorable television broadcast on Christmas Eve. I was 13 years old*, and watched with amazement.

I had already built the 1/96 scale Revell 'Apollo Spacecraft' as well as the larger 1/48 scale version.







It is reported that Revell will be reissuing these classic kits. Dragon issued a series of spacecraft kits in 1/72 scale a few years ago and they will be reissuing those this Spring.

* Some of you reading this may recall where you were at Christmas of 1968, and you may have been in the 'resorts' of South Vietnam or Thailand, or other similar garden spots in Southeast Asia.
