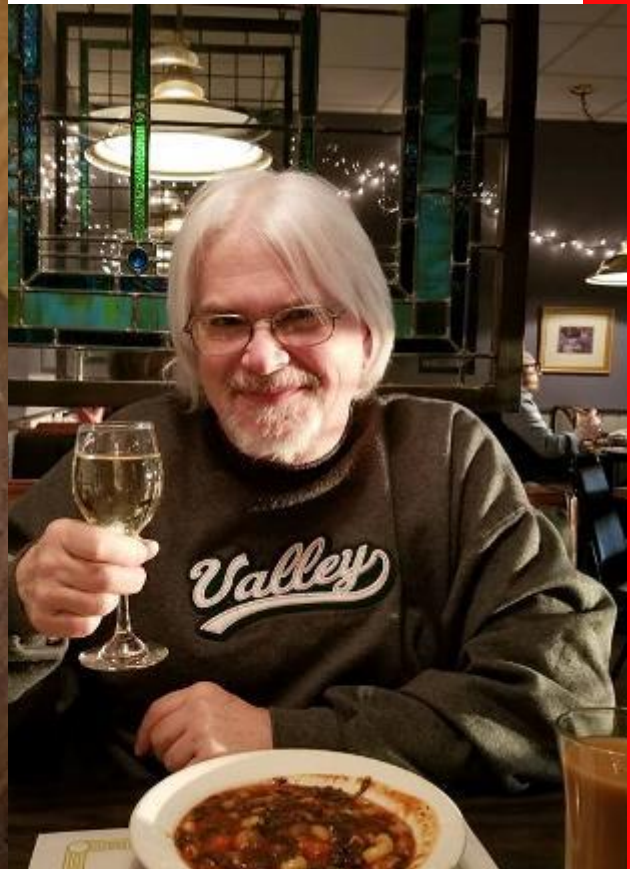

Chassis, Upper Hull and Track...(since I used Aftermarket FRUJIL Track (Winterketten). Follow the Instructions for the F/8 variant and your in. That just composed of filling a few lines and removing some ;) The track I soaked in BLACKEN-IT solvent to rust it up. I primed the entire kit (sanz track) Flat Black before adding three shades of gray. 47 more I coulda had a hit. It was looking great and I was tempted to leave it but those tracks just kept calling my name. Overspray of Flat White followed by a clear coat was all I did before a nice oil wash.....actually, a couple. I even broke out a new pair of cotton panties to remove the film. I flat Coated the Beast and decided to put a foil Flag for the ass end.....added a sprinkle of baking soda and there ya go.....Took about a week and had a Ball doing

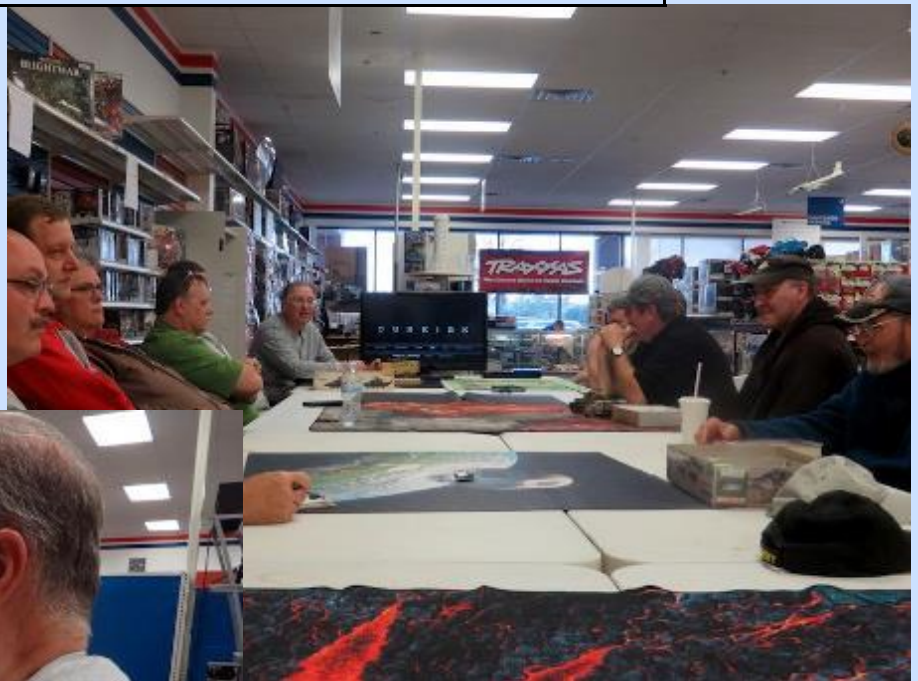
it! More on the Desk as we speak so I'll see ya soon. LOVE YA.....MISS YA.....Ya GOOSE!
