












DRAGON 1/35 Stug III Ausf. F/8 by Jack Bruno

Getting back into the swing of thingz as I finally got bored of the Supper Clubs. This Kit was a joy to build as are all of the CHEAP older mold DRAGON kits. This was the First Issue of the F/8 and it was built OOTB with a few exceptions Only Three Phazes to this build which were

Chassis, Upper Hull and Track...(since I used Aftermarket FRUIL Track (Winterketten). Follow the Instructions for the F/8 variant and your in. That just composed of filling a few lines and removing some;) The track I soaked in BLACKEN-IT solvent to rust it up. I primed the entire kit (sanz track) Flat Black before adding three shades of gray. 47 more I coulda had a hit. It was looking great and I was tempted to leave it but those tracks just kept calling my name. Overspray of Flat White followed by a clear coat was all I did before a nice oil wash.....actually, a couple. I even broke out a new pair of cotton panties to remove the film. I flat Coated the Beast and decided to put a foil Flag for the ass end.......added a sprinkle of baking soda and there ya go.......Took about a week and had a Ball doing


