After the unfortunate event of a stolen model at Baycon this month, Bob suggested that we explore ways in which we can police Granitecon. To have a model stolen at a show is very damaging for all involved. It also has the potential to harm the reputation of the club, as well as the future attendance of the show. This will be an ongoing discussion as we move into 2019.

Russell received news from the vendor coordinator for Noreastcon 2019 (April 12-13). Vendor tables are available with discounted hotel fees. Mac and John Rauscher will be attending this regional IPMS show. It was suggested that a GSM vendor table could be set up for any members who would like to reduce their stash of kits. Russell showed some interest in the idea and is considering vending with that purpose.
