20 February 2018 General Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by President Chris Merseal at 7:42 pm.

Attendance—22. No guests.

The first Modeler of the Year Contest was held, with all entries Out of the Box. Contest Chairman Marion Morris requested and got volunteer judges. This was also a build night.

Vice President Bill Wagner ran discussion and vote on the revised Constitution & By-Laws, which members present approved with only one vote against. This revision will go into effect immediately.

Wagner also brought up the suggestion of a longterm raffle for those who do things to the club getting an entry for an end of year prize, such as a gift card. This is meant to increase participation in club activities.

Treasurer Rick Keasey's article on last year's Adult Building Course (ABC) in Edwardsville appears in the current (Jan.-Feb.) IPMSUSA Journal, just out. He added he hopes to do the ABC again in Edwardsville this year.

Morris said Mark Twain Hobby Center sent him information on club member discounts and info required. This would be sent to the membership for further discussion.

Keasey mentioned attending the recent AMPS Atlanta show, which he greatly enjoyed and won silver awards for two of his entries. Upcoming shows in Indianapolis, Kansas City, Schaumburg, Illinois, and Tulsa were mentioned.

Morris announced the contest results. This contest drew 27 entries. (More on this on page 3 of this newsletter.)

The raffle prizes—Lindberg 1:72 scale Coast Guard Tug Boat, and two \$5 CRM Hobbies gift certificates—were all won by Jim Roeder, who donated these prizes to junior members present.


