

#### **Contest Notes**

Our contest operates on a "no sweeps" rule. That means that one can enter as many models in a category as he or she wants, but is only able to win one prize in that category (First Place, Second Place, or Third Place..

Models will be judged based on the basic workmanship of the model. Were seams filled? Were pin marks filled in? Were wheels/wings/masts/tracks aligned? No glue spots on the model? Are there any smudges on the clear parts? Any decal silvering? Inconsistent weathering?

Judging teams will be assigned at the judges meeting at 12:30 pm, prior to contest judging beginning at 1:00 pm. One may not judge in the category that he or she is entered in. Judges MAY NOT pick up models on the display tables, but may CAREFULLY move models on their entry sheets on the table. Any questions during the judging are to be referred to the contest chairman.

#### **Other Show Notes**

The kit raffle will raise funds for the United States Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots Program in Metropolitan St. Louis. Tickets may be placed in containers depending on the type of prizes desired (aircraft, armor, cars, ships, etc.). Tickets will be pulled at random during the day and will be posted on a board in the raffle area until the prizes are claimed. Donations for this raffle will be accepted the day of the show.

A special drawing will be made for an airbrush. This will be using separate tickets than for the kit raffle.

A free Make & Take model building session for the children will be done in the breakout room.

Lunch will be sold at the Holiday Inn, outside the show room. There are also several restaurants within a short drive from the show venue.
