18 June 2019 General Meeting Minutes

President Rick Keasey called the meeting to order at 7:31 pm. The 18 members attending were joined by one first-time guest: Carl Spalinger, who has been to our shows.

Vice President Bill Wagner began selling 50/50 raffle tickets, then Secretary Bob Delaney called the roll. Keasey asked for more member bios for the newsletter and website (12 up now), and for newsletter articles. He also reiterated that distribution of raffle prizes was restructured. Del Miller and Henry Puckett picked up their club polo shirts. Chapter Contact Marion Morris said our regional chapter and newsletter of the year nominations were on hold, as two other regions had yet to get their nominations in.

Keasey said he was glad that members were reading the newsletter. He mentioned that Slam Fest will be at next month's meeting, which starts at 7:00 pm SHARP. Embers will have two hours to assemble and finish a model kit, which will be judged by members a la the beauty contest. Trophy sponsors and raffle donations are needed for our show in September.

Regarding the IPMS National Convention in Chattanooga in August: Keasey wondered how any of us were going, and who would bring models for the display only table. He wants to know how many models to bring via email by the July general meeting. Those who bring display models will get raffle tickets there. Also, previous Nationals contest winners ay be displayed on a separate table.

In Show & Tell: Jim Triola with his Trumpeter 1:48 C-47 inflight with paratroopers jumping out on D-Day (and which took Second Place at the 2015 IPMS Nationals); Myron Lane with Pegasus 1:48 "War of the Worlds" Martian ship kit; Randy Kleeschulte with ICM 1:48 Spitfire Mk. IX kit, which he says is a challenge to build, but otherwise good; Don Will with two Warhammer figures that took Silver awards at WonderFest in Louisville on 31 May-2 June this year; Del Miller with blackdog.cz 1:48 Humvee Iraq War accessory set and Speed Hunter Graphics 1:48 A-10 "War-Weary Warthogs" decals; Bob Delaney with Walthers HO (1:87) P-51D Mustang Work in Progress (WIP), and Heller 1:72 Typhoon with D-Day Invasion Stripes he did 25 years ago; Larry Sigel with Revell box scale White Gas Truck (copyright 1956 on instructions) WIP. He asked for help with painting eyes on the two figures. Keasey and Will had suggestions on brushes; Mike Kuchar with Airfix 1:48 Spitfire Mk. XII, which he said worked out well; Henry Puckett with Revell 1:24 '68 VW Beetle; George Collier with Firing Line 1:76

Humber Heavy Utility Staff Car (white metal and brass kit), and Execuform 1:72 Douglas DC-5 vacuform kit; Dennis Bowman (interpreted by Albert White) with Revell 1:32 P-47, a 1:32 P-51, and a 1:48 military truck; Bill Wagner with approximately 1:6 Chinese kit of machine gun, and two items found at Savers store—1:48 Sd.Kfz.251 and 1:32(?) M16 halftracks, both already built; and, Rick Keasey with a vignette of two figures—a Stalingrad surrendering German soldier, and an unknown kit of a US soldier.

Morris did a demo on how primer colors can affect the top coat on models. He showed that paints can affect how details on a model show through on the top coat. Morris used Mr. Paint colors, which he very much likes. Using black basing helped panel lines to top put. Morris uses black primer on an aircraft undersurface, and a light gray primer on the upper surface. Morris uses a CO2 tank with his airbrush, getting the tank and its refills from CK Welding Supply. This setup is quiet and dry, he added.

Keasey asked members for demo ideas for upcoming meetings.

The 50/50 raffle drawing was held. \$44 was raised this night, with \$22 to Toys for Tots and \$22 to the winner, Rick Keasey.

Raffle tickets were drawn for those who brought Show & Tell items. Bob Delaney won the book "Der Adler: The Official Nazi Luftwaffe Magazine," and Henry Puckett won the Takom 1:35 M3 Lee Mid kit.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:01 pm.

2019 Modeler of the Year Contests

19 February. Special Category: Out of the Box (ALL ENTRIES)

21 May. Special Category: 6 is a Serious Number (6/Six in the subject's name or designation)

17 September. Special Category: Let's Go Topless (Open cockpit aircraft, convertible cars, open-topped armored vehicles, etc.)

19 November. Special Category: Italiano (Italian subjects)

Each contest has these regular categories: Aircraft, Armor, Automotive, Ships, Space/Sci-Fi, Dioramas, Figures, Miscellaneous, and Juniors.

You receive one point for entering each model in the contest, and an additional point for entering in the Special Category. Category winners receive three points, second place earns two points, and third place gets one point. We operate with "no sweeps" rules, so you can only earn one prize per category, no matter how many entries you have in that category.








Rick Keasey showed off this 1:35 vignette. The surrendering German soldier at right is a Stalingrad figure. The maker of the US solder figure at left is unknown.
