












## The 2018 VA Shoot -Out.... Announces two new categories.

Out of Box rules apply and will be strictly enforced.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded.

These categories are "stand alone" and will not be considered for any other awards. However it is points heavy towards the Shoot-Out club award. Therefore club participation will be an advantage. The two designated kits for 2018 are:

P-51 Mustang 1/48 scale Revell-Monogram


1966 Mustang 1/25 scale AMT
